

Steps to Obtain Your MAT Waiver



1

Check Your Eligibility

To apply for a waiver you must have a valid medical license and an active DEA number. Apply for a DEA number with Drug Enforcement Agency's Diversion Control Division (Registration Support) [here](#).

Take 24 hours of required coursework

PCSS offers for FREE the required 24 hours of medication assisted treatment (MAT) [waiver training](#) with continuing education (8 hour MAT and 16 hour course).

Complete your Notice of Intent Form

Once you have finished the 24 hours of training, complete the NOI form [online](#) and submit it to the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) for review.



3

Forward your Certificates of Completion to SAMHSA

When you complete the 8-hour waiver training and 16-hour training, PCSS will send you via email your certificates of completion for each. Fax the certificates to 301 576-5237 or [email](#) it to SAMHSA.

Once SAMHSA has obtained all documentation, the process requires approximately 45 days.
