

## Appendix 5: Community Partner ID Worksheet

### Community Partner/Resource Identification Worksheet

**Instructions:** The purpose of this worksheet is to brainstorm organizations and services within your community and/or region that may be critical partners to enhancing your program’s capacity to provide SUD services. First, identify organizations within each category, list the primary services they provide and your current relationship (e.g., already refer or share clients; have contacts but have not yet partnered; have an idea of what services they provide but do not yet have contact person). If your program does not know any organizations within certain categories, investigate whether there might be organizations in your community/region. The goal is to identify and establish relationships with as many local partners as possible to help support and extend your capacity (and theirs) to effectively treat people with SUD.
